## Fifteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

Dear brothers and sisters,

Last week we saw Jesus being rejected by his people. That was to be expected since He began a new way of living faith. It was to be expected that his disciples, by carrying the same teachings, were going to confront difficulties in their mission. Jesus knew this, when he sent them. We believe that they were young people without much experience, and with few instructions. The specific guidance that Jesus gave them was very simple. However, the power and strength given by the master would help them achieve their purpose. The message that Jesus commissioned them to bring was also very simple, but at the same time powerful and profound. They were to preach about love and forgiveness. There were to be many who were not going to like this teaching, especially given by some inexperienced young people, who, with some understandable trepidation, were doing it in the name of Jesus. But Jesus was with them. The force of the sending (mission) and the fact that they were accompanied (that is, with another as a witness), allowed them to follow their paths as the teacher indicated. Today, we are also sent out into a very complicated, complex and convulsed world. A world that is rejecting not only religions, those who lead them and those who follow them, but also God himself. We are also afraid to talk about love and forgiveness, about God or Jesus. It is feeling helpless, or in the words of Jesus, "like sheep in the midst of wolves." Or we could say, like gentle doves in the midst of wild beasts. The important thing is to remember that the teacher is still by our side, he will always accompany us in our mission to carry his message. It doesn't necessarily have to be with words; our way of imitating Christ will speak more eloquently. May God bless you this week.

## Decimoquinto Domingo del Tiempo Ordinario

Queridos hermanos y hermanas,

La semana pasada vimos a Jesús ser rechazado por los suyos. Eso era de esperarse pues inició una nueva manera de vivir la fe. Era de esperarse que sus discípulos, al llevar las mismas enseñanzas de su maestro, iban a confrontar dificultades en su misión. Jesús sabiéndolo los envía. Podríamos pensar que eran unos jóvenes sin mucha experiencia, con pocas instrucciones, y las que les dio Jesús fueron muy sencillas. Sin embargo, el poder y la fuerza dada por el maestro les ayudaría a realizarla. El mensaje que Jesús encomendó llevar también fue muy sencillo, pero a la vez poderoso y profundo. Pero Jesús estaba con ellos. La fuerza del envío y el hecho de que iban acompañados, es decir, con otro como testigo, permitió que siguieran los caminos tal y como el maestro les indicó. Nosotros hoy día también somos enviados a un mundo muy complicado, complejo y convulsionado. Un mundo que está rechazando no solo las religiones, a los que las dirigen y a los que los siguen, sino también a Dios mismo. A nosotros también nos da miedo hablar del amor y del perdón, de Dios o de Jesús. Es sentirse impotente, o en palabras de Jesús, "como ovejas en medio de lobos". Podríamos decir, como mansas palomas en medio de bestias salvajes. Lo importante es recordar que el maestro sigue a nuestro lado, él nos acompañará siempre en nuestra misión de llevar su mensaje. Que no necesariamente tiene que ser con palabras, nuestra manera de imitar a Cristo hablará con mayor elocuencia. Dios les bendiga en esta semana.

Hoje também somos enviados para um mundo muito complicado, complexo e convulsionado. Um mundo que rejeita não só as religiões, aqueles que as lideram e aqueles que as seguem, mas também o próprio Deus. Também temos medo de falar de amor e perdão, de Deus ou de Jesus. É sentir-se desamparado, ou nas palavras de Jesus, "como ovelhas no meio de lobos". Poderíamos dizer, como pombas mansas no meio de feras selvagens. O importante é lembrar que o professor continua ao nosso lado, ele sempre nos acompanhará em nossa missão de levar sua mensagem. Não precisa ser necessariamente com palavras, a nossa forma de imitar a Cristo falará com mais eloquência. Deus te abençoe esta semana.

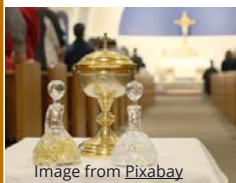
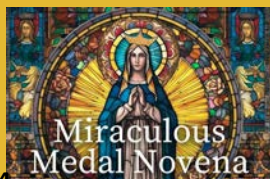

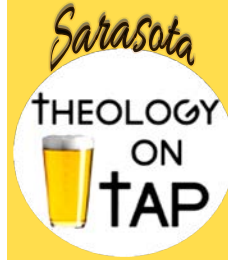

**Abortion Amendment to Florida's Constitution**

**Vote 'No' on Amendment 4**

Revised June 6, 2024

The Church plays a role in the promotion and attainment of justice and protection of the common good. As faithful citizens, we are called to participate in public life and to apply Gospel values to our political activities. Our actions in the public square must reflect the values of our faith and demonstrate a fundamental belief in the dignity of every person and the sacredness of all human life.

A proposed amendment to our state constitution that seeks to legalize abortion through the third trimester will appear on the November 2024 ballot. While Catholic opposition to abortion is well known, even our friends and neighbors who would tolerate abortion to some degree are finding the proposed amendment too extreme and even deceptive. Let me explain a few key components of the Amendment:

- This amendment was cleverly worded to hide the fact that it would eliminate current laws and common-sense safety regulations for abortions that most people on both sides of this issue support. For example, while the amendment allows for parental *notification* before a daughter undergoes an abortion, it would eliminate the current law that requires parental *consent*, making this the only medical decision for which parents have no say.
- The amendment explicitly allows abortion until the preborn child is viable, which is at about 22-24 weeks, or 6 months, of pregnancy. It then provides a loophole to allow "health care providers," which under Florida law do not have to be doctors, to justify practically any abortion after that point. Even employees of abortion clinics who are not doctors would be able to approve late-term abortions.
- Unlike other proposed constitutional amendments, the text of the amendment does not define key terms like "government interference," "viability," "patient's health" and "health care provider." Without these definitions, the amendment, if passed, will cause countless lawsuits and years of legal uncertainty.

The bishops of Florida have urged all Floridians to pray for protections for the preborn and mothers in need, and to stand against the legalization of late-term abortion by voting 'no' on Amendment 4.



**Enmienda a la Constitución de la Florida sobre el Aborto**

**Vote 'No' a la Enmienda 4**

Revisado: 6 de junio de 2024

La Iglesia desempeña un rol en la promoción y consecución de la justicia y la protección del bien común. Como ciudadanos fieles, estamos llamados a participar en la vida pública y a aplicar los valores del Evangelio a nuestras actividades políticas. Nuestras acciones en la esfera pública deben reflejar los valores de nuestra fe y demostrar una creencia fundamental en la dignidad de cada persona y en el carácter sagrado de toda vida humana.

En la papeleta electoral de noviembre de 2024 aparecerá una propuesta de enmienda a la constitución de nuestro estado que pretende legalizar el aborto hasta el tercer trimestre. Aunque la oposición católica al aborto es muy conocida, incluso nuestros amigos y vecinos que tolerarían el aborto en alguna medida consideran que la enmienda propuesta es demasiado extrema, y hasta engañosa. Permítanme explicarles algunos componentes principales de la enmienda:

- Esta enmienda fue redactada con astucia para ocultar el hecho de que eliminaría las leyes actuales y las normas de seguridad de sentido común para los abortos, apoyadas por la mayoría de las personas en ambos lados de este asunto. Por ejemplo: aunque la enmienda permite la notificación a los padres antes de que una hija se someta a un aborto, eliminaría la ley actual que exige el consentimiento parental, convirtiéndola en la única decisión médica sobre la que los padres no tienen voz ni voto.
- La enmienda permite de modo explícito el aborto hasta que el feto sea viable, es decir, entre las 22 y las 24 semanas, o 6 meses, de embarazo. Luego establece una oportunidad para permitir que los "proveedores del cuidado de la salud", que según la ley de Florida no tienen que ser médicos, justifiquen prácticamente cualquier aborto después de ese tiempo. Incluso los empleados de las clínicas abortistas que no sean médicos podrían aprobar los abortos tardíos.
- A diferencia de otras enmiendas constitucionales propuestas, el texto de la enmienda no define términos fundamentales como "interferencia del gobierno", "viabilidad", "salud del paciente" y "proveedor de cuidados de la salud". Sin estas definiciones, la enmienda, si se aprueba, provocará innumerables demandas y años de incertidumbre jurídica.

Los obispos de la Florida han exhortado a todos los floridianos a orar por la protección de los recién nacidos y de las madres necesitadas, y a oponerse a la legalización del aborto tardío al votar "no" a la Enmienda 4.

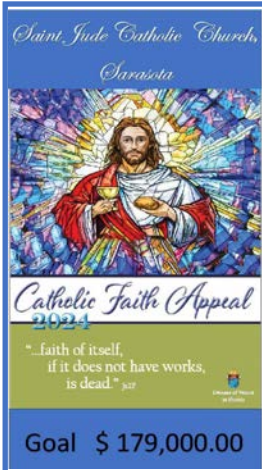

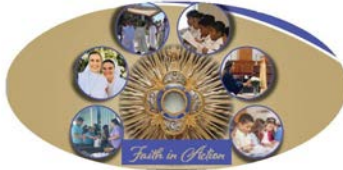

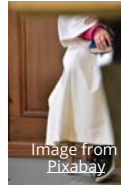
